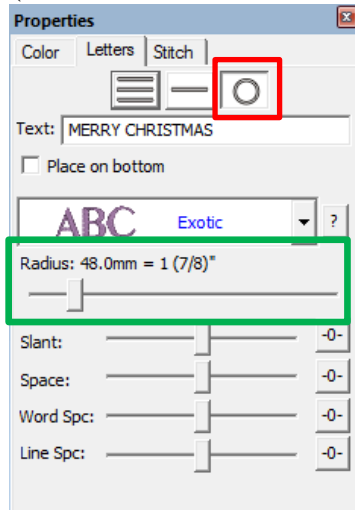

Instructions


At the Computer:

1. Open the program by clicking on the EmbroideryWorks  icon on the desktop.
2. To place the design on the workspace click on Merge Stitch File  and retrieve design #SWNCF118.PES from the saved location.
3. Click on the Create Letter  icon on the top toolbar.
4. In the Properties field select Text on a Circle (as shown below in the red box).
5. With the Caps Lock on, type "MERRY CHRISTMAS" in the Text field.
6. Resize the lettering to the smallest size possible, by dragging inward on one of the selecting handles. The radius 48mm and size 1 7/8" will be (shown below in the illustration within the green box).



7. Position the lettering centered above the flower design (as shown below).



8. To change the color of the lettering, click on the Color tab in the Properties field and select Christmas Red.
9. Select both designs and click on Center Designs in the Hoop .
10. To create a template of the lettering design for placement, click on File Print.
11. Click on File Save As (Stitch and Working File). The working file format is a .be.
12. Hoop the stabilizer and spray with the temporary spray adhesive.
13. Pin the template to the center of the blank wrap.
14. Place the templated wrap in the center of the hoop and finger press smooth.
15. With the machine set up for embroidery, retrieve the design and center the needle over the cross mark on the template. Remove the template and embroider the design using the thread colors of your choice.
